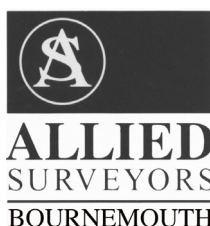

With newcomer Tim Collier forced to retire after half an hour, Bournemouth surrendered a sixteen points lead to leave themselves trailing 16-22 with ten or so minutes to go. However, they rallied with the restoration of loosehead prop Tim Wareham after having served ten minutes in the sin bin and for the same player to drive over and score a vital try in consecutive matches. The score came after immense pressure on the Coney Hill line and after Jo Burns being unlucky not to be credited with a score with referee Tom Foley ordering a 5-metre scrum instead. Fly-half Mike Pope kicked the match-winning goal for Bournemouth to snatch victory out of the jaws defeat leaving Coney Hill pondering about what might have been.
