**Bournemouth add to Newbury's Blues**

**Result:** Bournemouth 112/18t12c v 5/t Newbury Blues. **Half-time:** 57/9t6c.

**Weather:** Cool overcast day with a Westerly breeze that blew straight down the pitch.

**Ground:** The ground was firm under foot with a good covering of grass.

**Kick-off:** Newbury Blues (Oscar Matthews) kicked off right to left as viewed from the stand.

**A**n 18-try defeat tells its own tale as Newbury struggle to come to terms with the dramatic turn in their fortunes. Needless to say is a record score against our long-standing rivals but is also a league record for Bournemouth, overtaking the 105-5, sixteen try defeat of Minety in Southern Counties South in 2004/2005. Congratulations to James Flynn on equalling Guy Spencer's record of five hat-tricks in a league career and Robert Bruce and Anthony Dunkerley on scoring their first hat-trick for the club. It is the first time three hat-tricks have been scored in a league match and the first time the same player (James Flynn) has scored a hat-trick in successive matches—it is only the third time a hat-trick has been scored in successive matches. The first time was ironically on exactly the same two Saturdays in 2005, 1 and 8 October.
